

To help assure your protection as well as others, here's what to expect when you come to our campus:

- All staff and volunteers (with the exception of those on the platform while leading worship or speaking) will be wearing masks.
- Hand-sanitizing stations will be available at the Welcome center and other locations placed throughout the building.
- Our **CELEBRATION PLACE** for kids and NURSERY is NOT open yet. Until Celebration Place re-opens, we highly encourage you to find other options for your children. Our CR Large group services are designed for adults, and testimonies that are shared often contain mature content. We also don't want children getting in front of the cameras. Adults who choose to bring children to CR Large Group will need to keep their family together with them. This means that children need to stay in their seats with their family and not roam the aisles, pews or worship center. Children 2 years and older will need to wear a mask. Please consider all this before bringing children to large group Celebrate Recovery. **ONCE CELEBRATION PLACE RE-OPENS ON CHILDREN WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN OUR CR LARGE GROUP. No Children or anyone under 18 will be allowed in our adult open share groups.**
- **THE LANDING** for our teens on campus is also NOT open at this time.
- Water fountains will be turned off, so bring bottled water with you.
- No beverages or food will be served. (**NO Dinner @ 5:45pm or Café Recovery @ 9pm.**)
- Offering baskets will not be passed. Instead, offering receptacles will be in place.
- All pew-back materials, cards, and pens will be removed.
- You will be helped with flow in and out of the building and worship center by ushers and greeters. Once you have entered the worship center, plan to remain in your pew until worship is over and your row is dismissed.
- **BATHROOMS:** Limited access – 2 people at a time in lobby restrooms.

Here's how you can help:

- If you don't feel well, are immune-compromised or have other health concerns that make you vulnerable, please stay home and join us online.
- Be sure to ask yourself the following questions before attending: (1) Am I showing any flu-like symptoms? (2) Have I had a fever of 100.4 or higher in the past 14 days? (3) Have I had prolonged exposure to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19? (4) Is there any medical reason why I believe I shouldn't be around others? Note: If you answered yes to any of these questions, we strongly encourage you to watch us online.
- **Wear a mask anytime you are in our SHBC Facilities** out of respect for others around you. Greeters will have masks on hand to provide for those who forget to bring one.
- Please park in our Main West Parking Lot and enter through the West Parking Lot doors only.
- **Please wash your hands and use hand sanitizer often.**
- **Maintain a distance of six feet between yourself and other guests** while on campus. Family groups, of course, will be able to sit together.
- Continue to stay engaged online if you are not coming in person on Friday nights and invite others to join you- through watch parties on Facebook.
